

# THE BETWEEN-TIME MESSAGE DUMP

*A Recovered Continuity Archive*

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## On This Document

The two records that precede this one were chosen. The Public Record survived because power preserves what flatters it. The Informal Record survived because a few people decided, deliberately, that an erased thing deserved to reappear. Both passed through a hand that meant to keep them.

This did not.

What follows was recovered from a single continuity provider's message-relay archive — the undifferentiated traffic of ordinary accounts across nine years, retained for operational reasons that were never disclosed, and released, in a form nobody curated, by a process this Institute cannot fully reconstruct. We did not select these fragments to make a point. We have done two things to them: ordered them by date, and removed what would identify the living.

We have added no notes.

This is a departure from our practice, and we want to be plain about why. Our notes exist to supply the context a reader needs. Here, context is the thing the document is about — and a reader told in advance what a fragment means has been robbed of the only experience the fragment offers, which is the experience of noticing. These messages were written by people who did not believe anything was happening. The record is only honest if you are permitted to not-believe it alongside them, for as long as that lasts.

It does not last. You will feel the place where it stops. We have chosen not to mark it, because no one who lived through it was marked at the time. They looked up one day, the way you are about to, and found that the ordinary thing had become the other thing while they were busy being unbothered.

The dates grow more precise as the record goes on. This is not our doing. It is a property of the source: in the early years people logged little and meant less by it, and by the end the timestamps are exact to the minute, because by the end everything was logged, all the time, by systems that had stopped being asked to.

Read it the way it was lived: forward, without warning.

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*[The archive ends here. The final account remained open and received no further messages. The record does not say whether this is because the person stopped writing, or because they had reached the place where there was no longer a difference between writing and being written, or because they had simply, at last, put it down. We have left the silence where we found it. It is the only part of this record that no one drafted.]*

*The archive remains open. No one is reaching for it.*
